Item #1 Paul Vezmar; 234 S. Lindberg. Requesting permission for a Public Hearing on a Use Variance to open a laser tag entertainment area. Property is zoned 12; Heavy Industrial.

Mr. Paul Vezmar appeared before the Board. Mr. Vezmar stated the facility is not going to be used for laser tag, it will actually be a Nerf and urban dodgeball battle area, similar to a paintball field and/or laser tag area. There are plans to lay down a ¾" rubber floor, with inflatable objects and mobile drums which will make up the arena spaces. The experience is geared towards a more mature audience and will likely be sought after for private parties. The warehouse is 5,000 square feet, with 1,000 square foot office area. The warehouse is large enough that there can be 2 private parties simultaneously. Mr. Vezmar then distributed pictures of a similar business in the Detroit area. Mr. Vezmar stated he also received written permission from the property to owner to request the Variance. Mr. Wichlinski made a motion granting Paul Vezmar; 234 S. Lindberg permission to advertise for a Public Hearing on a Use Variance to open a Nerf/Urban Dodgeball entertainment area seconded by Mr. Elbaor. All favored, motion carried.
