A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE EMERGENCY PURCHASE OF A USED FIRE TRUCK FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT IN THE TOWN OF GRIFFITH, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA, AND ALL RELATED MATTERS.

WHEREAS, the Safety Board of the Town of Griffith, Lake County, Indiana, is a duly organized and established entity by enabling Ordinance of the Town of Griffith, Lake County, Indiana, authorized and empowered by statutory authority to purchase the equipment needed by the Fire Department, make general and special rules for the government and discipline within the Fire Department, as well as to make special and general orders to the Fire Department through the Fire Chief, the Executive Head of the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the Safety Board of the Town of Griffith, Lake County, Indiana, has undertaken and been actively engaged in the fulfillment of its duties and responsibilities as the Safety Board to the Griffith Fire Department since appointed; and

WHEREAS, the Safety Board of the Town of Griffith, Lake County, Indiana, has been advised and informed by and through Fire Chief Roy Schoon and Deputy Chief Mike Andree Jr. that an emergency condition has arisen, namely, one of its fire trucks (Unit 213 American Lafrance Century VIN: 1P2F11039MA901019) has fallen into mere collector's status due to the fact that the manufacturer will no longer support parts to fix it; and

WHEREAS, the Safety Board of the Town of Griffith, Lake County, Indiana, has been further advised by the Fire Chiefs that a threat to the public health, welfare and safety to the citizens of Griffith exists, as there is no way to ensure that Unit 213 will be operable during an emergency without access to parts necessary to keep it in good maintenance and operation; and

WHEREAS, the Griffith Safety Board, having previously designated Deputy Chief Mike Andree Jr. to issue a Letter of Intent to purchase a replacement fire truck, negotiate Unit 213 for trade-in value and put down a 10% deposit required to hold the replacement fire truck pending inspection and confirmation by Fire Department personnel that this replacement fire truck is in a safe and operable condition, now has been advised that the inspection was successful and that purchasing the replacement truck for the negotiated price of \$139,500 is a considerable value and a substantial savings to the Town.

WHEREAS, the Safety Board of the Town of Griffith, Lake County, Indiana, now determines that it is in the best interests of the residents of the Town of Griffith and the Griffith Fire Department to immediately proceed to acquire and purchase the replacement fire truck through special purchasing; and
