 Police Chief Tharp read the monthly report for June 2025.

Officer Austin Tucker represented Griffith FOP Lodge #161 at tonight's meeting. Officer Tucker advised he has served as a Griffith Police Officer for the past three (3) years and currently serves as a board member of the Griffith Fraternal Order of Police (FOP). Officer Tucker stated he was here on behalf of the Griffith FOP to share a brief but meaningful update. He stated the FOP is proud to announce that the Griffith Police Department now has 100% participation in the Griffith FOP – EVERY officer has chosen to stand together as part of their organization.

Officer Tucker stated the FOP would like to extend their sincere appreciation to the Public Safety Board. The Board's continued support and partnership means a great deal to the FOP, and they are grateful for the Board's commitment to our department and the work that the officers do.

NEW BUSINESS

- 1. Griffith Police Department presents Certificate of Commendation to:
 - a. Officer Daniel Arroyo

Chief Tharp advised Officer Arroyo, Corporal Beck, Officer Sekula and Lieutenant Sines responded to a domestic disturbance involving a suicidal subject armed with a gun. After a coordinated search, the subject emerged from between two (2) cars and approached Officer Arroyo's vehicle holding a gun by the barrel, grip extended. Demonstrating exceptional restraint and situational awareness, Officer Arroyo calmy addressed the subject and had him place the gun on the ground and step back, allowing Corporal Beck to safely secure the weapon.

This incident presented significant danger to not only the officers but also to the subject in crisis. Officer Arroyo's quick judgement and composed response prevented a potentially fatal outcome. While acknowledging the sensitivity surrounding mental health and use-of-force incidents, this nomination is offered with care and respect – not to sensationalize a personal crisis, but to recognize exemplary restraint, compassion, and teamwork during a volatile situation.

All involved officers showed commendable professionalism, with Officer Arroyo deserving special recognition for his actions.







Commander C. Burrow presented Officer Arroyo with his Certificate of Commendation.
