Police Chief Mance read the monthly report for May.

Chief Mance reported that overall crime for May, when compared to May 2014, has decreased 7%. However when compared to the average of the past 5 years, May 2015 saw a 19% reduction of crime.

Centralized dispatch target date for completion is still October 2015 with the radio towers waiting on height regulations.

### Griffith Fire Department

Chief Schoon read the May monthly report.

The Fire Department has been participating in the Central Market with a booth handing out CO and smoke detectors, selling tickets to their fundraiser, and recruiting new members.

The new rescue truck has been approved by the Town Council with a completion target date of nine (9) months.

The Fire Department Association donated five (5) sets of forcible entry tools valued at \$2,300.00 as well as donated funds to purchase remote garage door openers for each of our bay doors valued at \$2,800.
