1. PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS:

a. David Thompson, 247 N Indiana, Griffith: Presented an alternate route for the proposed South Shore Extension. ORDINANCE NO. 2017-_07___

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 6. AMUSEMENTS, IN ITS ENTIRETY

WHEREAS, IC 36-1-32-2 confers upon all local units of government the powers that they need for the effective operation of government as to local affairs; and

WHEREAS, IC 36-1-3-6(b)(1) prescribes that any such exercise of power shall be authorized through the enactment of an ordinance passed by the legislative body; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Griffith, Lake County, Indiana, has determined that it is not in the best financial interest of the Town to continue expending town resources involved in the collecting of fees and documentation required under Chapter 6. Amusements of the Town Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Griffith, Lake County, Indiana, as follows:

Chapter 6. Amusements of the Town Code of the Town of Griffith shall hereinafter be repealed and be of no further force and effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any and all such ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Town of Griffith that are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and of no further force or effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and posting in accordance with IC 36-5-2-10.

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 50 – PARKS & RECREATION, ARTICLE III – PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS; DIVISION 2 – PERMIT, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SEC. 50-82

WHEREAS, IC 36-1-32-2 confers upon all local units of government the powers that they need for the effective operation of government as to local affairs; and

WHEREAS, IC 36-1-3-6(b)(1) prescribes that any such exercise of power shall be authorized through the enactment of an ordinance passed by the legislative body; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Griffith, Lake County, Indiana, has been asked by the Town of Griffith Board of Parks and Recreation to establish by ordinance park rental rates.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Griffith, Lake County, Indiana, as follows:

Chapter 50 – Parks and Recreation Article III – Park Rules and Regulation; Division 2 – Permit, shall be amended by the addition of a new Sec. 50-82, which shall hereinafter read as follows:

Sec. 50-82. Pavilion Rental Information

Cheever Park	Resident: \$50/4 hours Non-Resident: \$75/4 hours	Resident: \$75/Day Non-Resident: \$150/Day	\$50	Softball field, public restroom, electricity, horseshoe pit, tennis courts, handball courts, playground

Rental Fees must be paid in full within 10 days and are non-refundable. All rules will be closely enforced by withholding the deposit.

Weddings and/or extra-large gatherings are subject to additional permits and fees.

SOLICITING: Soliciting, peddling, collecting fees, fund-raising or the sale of items, merchandise, or food is not allowed on park property without an official permit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any and all such ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Town of Griffith that are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and of no further force or effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and posting in accordance with IC 36-5-2-10.
