MS Dixon expressed concerns about the timing of the project and what type of notice she would receive as the project approaches her residence. She was advised that she would receive notice via mail and/or a door hanger. Tracy of 1230 N Wood stated that her fence was approximately two feet into the easement and what would happen if the fence had to be removed for the project. She was advised that the fence would be replaced if necessary. David of 505 E Glen Park wanted to know if the project would cause a disruption in service to the Laundromat that he runs at that address. He stated that he would allow access to his property but was concerned about the loss of business if he is not allowed to discharge into the sewer. He was advised that he would be contacted and that further analysis is necessary for his particular location. A representative from Wessler Engineering was present at the meeting and addressed the concerns and stayed after adjournment to answer questions.
