ORDINANCE 2016-05

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 74 - TRAFFIC & VEHICLES, ARTICLE VIII TRAFFIC SCHEDULES, SECTION 74-302 LIMITED PARKING ON CERTAIN STREETS (b)

WHEREAS, IC 9-21-1-3 et seq. authorizes the Town to adopt traffic and parking regulations within the Town of Griffith; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Griffith, Lake County, Indiana, deems it to be in the best interest of the general health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Griffith that Chapter 74 - Traffic & Vehicles, Article VIII, Traffic Schedules, Section 74-302, Limited Parking on Certain Streets (b), be amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Griffith, Lake County, Indiana, that Chapter 74 – Traffic & Vehicles, Article VIII, Traffic Schedules, Section 74-302, Limited Parking on Certain Streets (b), be amended by the addition of the following:

On the west side of the 200 block of Griffith Boulevard, the first 200 feet north of Columbia Street shall be reserved for parking only by residents of the 200 block of Griffith Boulevard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any and all such ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Town of Griffith that are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and of no further force or effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and posting in accordance with IC 36-5-2-10.
