#### APPROVAL OF CLAIMS:

Council Member Glen Gaby moved to grant permission and to authorize the committee to make purchases and enter contracts as needed for the success of the festival and to close the 100 and 200 blocks of N Broad to vehicle traffic beginning at 8:00 p.m. August 27<sup>th</sup> through no later than 10:00 a.m. September 1<sup>st</sup>, second by Council Member Larry Ballah. - 2. Standard and Poor's Rating Services announced the rating for the Griffith Redevelopment Authority Road Improvement Bonds. Clerk Treasurer George Jerome explained that the rating of AA- will result in significant savings on interest expense over the 20-year life of the bonds. According to S&P, the ratings reflect Griffith's "Very strong budgetary flexibility, very strong budgetary performance and very strong liquidity."
